General Waste Management Program

This program has been developed so that any waste materials generated by Burns Industrial Equipment will be disposed of in an environment friendly manor. All Burns Industrial Equipment employees are to follow these guidelines for waste disposal. A list of these materials is included in this program. Our goal is to take care of the environment in a responsible way.

Waste Materials that we generate

Any light bulbs, fluorescent or incandescent

Fluids including motor oil, hydraulic oil, transmission oil, paint thinner, and antifreeze.

Filters (oil, trans, hyd, fuel, and air)

Empty containers (spray cans, oil containers)

Used or broken forklift parts

Tires (solid or pneumatic)

Environment friendly manor of disposal

All light bulbs are to be disposed through the Waste Management Lamp Tracker Program.

Waste oils are to be emptied into our large waste oil tank and then used as fuel for heating.

Paint thinner and antifreeze should be emptied into the marked containers for paint thinner and antifreeze and Safety Kleen will dispose.

All oil type filters will be crushed and the filters will be disposed in our steel recycling bin.

Empty spray containers, oil containers, non-steel parts, and air filters will dispose in the trash.

All metal forklift parts will be disposed in our steel recycling bin.

Tires will be disposed by the tire vendor.
